Master Plan Revision

Comment Period: October 28 through November 27, 2016

The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers is in the process of revising the John Martin Reservoir Master Plan. The master plan revision will guide the land and recreational management of the federally owned property that make up the reservoir and its shoreline for the next 25 years. Management activities include protecting natural and cultural resources, providing public land and water recreation, promoting visitor safety, and ensuring reservoir and dam operations. A map of the current land uses can be found on the back of the comment form for reference. Public input is especially needed regarding revised land use classifications and preparation of management plans. Definitions and examples of these terms are provided in the presentation noted below.
