The Albuquerque District, U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, has prepared the following final document for public review:

**General Reevaluation Report /
Supplemental Environmental Impact Statement II:
Rio Grande Floodway, San Acacia to Bosque del Apache Unit,
Socorro County, New Mexico**

The report describes a proposed flood risk management project along the Rio Grande from San Acacia downstream to San Marcial. The recommended plan is to replace the existing embankment between the Low Flow Conveyance Channel and the Rio Grande with a structurally competent levee capable of containing high-volume, long-duration flows. This engineered levee would substantially reduce the risk of damage from floods emanating from the Rio Grande. The local cost-sharing sponsors of the proposed project are the Middle Rio Grande Conservancy District and the New Mexico Interstate Stream Commission.

The public review period begins on January 24, 2014 and ends on February 24, 2014. A Record of Decision for the proposed action will be issued after February 24, 2014.
