2.4.1 **Soft Metric.** Soft Metric design typically applies to products and measurements that conform to I-P modules, standards, or other controlling factors and are expressed in metric values which are exact mathematical conversions of the corresponding I-P values. Converted measurements will be expressed to the minimum number of significant digits that will maintain the required accuracy in accordance with ASTM Standard Manual E 380-92.

2.4.2 **Masonry Design.** Concrete masonry units (CMU) manufactured to metric modules are not readily, therefore I-P CMU designations are used in this document and may be used for design.

2.4.3 **Mechanical Design.** Chapter 35 of the ASHRAE Handbook Fundamentals is a good source for metric conversion for mechanical design.

2.5 **Drawings.** Drawings included in the Planning Document provided in Appendix B are included for information on the site layout and shall be used in the design of the facility. Drawings are not available in electronic format.

2.5.1 **Field Information.** The utility information provided in the Planning Document is the best information available. It is provided to assist the Contractor during the design of this project. The Contractor is responsible for field verifying all information given. The Contractor is also responsible for obtaining all information necessary to properly design and install all work. Gathering information during design shall be coordinated through the Contracting Officer. Any survey required to provide utility locations, manhole inverts, verification of existing features, etc., shall be the responsibility of the Contractor and shall tie into the project datum.

2.5.2 **Design Details and Standards.** The Contractor shall provide a design and construction package which uses the design details given or referenced in this RFP. Additional details shall be created by the Contractor as required, but shall conform to the requirements of this RFP and are subject to approval by Government.

2.6 **Specifications.** The Contractor shall provide a design and construction package which uses the specifications provided in Volume 2 of this RFP, and in accordance with Appendix G. See Section 01012 for additional information concerning allowable specifications. If any additional specifications are required, the Contractor shall identify the need in writing to the Contracting Officer and Government will provide the necessary specifications in electronic guide form. Specifications for items not identified in Volume II shall be written by the Contractor. The Contractor shall edit the guide specifications, but edits shall conform to the specific minimum standard requirements of this RFP and are subject to approval by the Government.

(7) 2.7 **Building Sustainability.** The Baca/Dlo'ay Azhi Consolidated Replacement School shall consider building sustainability, or "green building" design. Building systems, materials, orientation, etc., must be selected with consideration to the LEED certification requirements for these buildings. The LEED Green Building Rating System™ is a priority program of the US Green Building Council, and is required for this facility. This project is required to be LEED certified at the "Bronze" or higher level. (7)
