

Notice of Availability of Draft Environmental Assessment for the  
Las Cruces West Mesa Industrial Park, Las Cruces, Doña Ana County, New Mexico

Pursuant to the Council on Environmental Quality regulations that implement the National Environmental Policy Act, the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (Corps), Albuquerque District, has completed a Draft Environmental Assessment (DEA) and Finding of No Significant Impact (FONSI) for a proposal to extend the existing sanitary sewer line at the Las Cruces West Mesa Industrial Park, Las Cruces, New Mexico. The project area is located on both sides of Interstate Highway 10 (I-10), west of Las Cruces in Doña Ana County, New Mexico.

The proposed project would: 1) construct a lift station on the north side of I-10; 2) construct a sewer line with multiple discharge points from the Las Cruces International Airport along Crawford Road to the lift station; 3) construct a sewer line from the National Guard Armory along north frontage road to the lift station; and 4) construct a sewer line under I-10 from the lift stations to an existing industrial park sewer line south of I-10.

Public review of the Draft Environmental Assessment will begin on March 5, 2008 and will run for 30 days until April 4.
