The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, Albuquerque District, has completed the Environmental Assessment for the Galisteo Dam and Reservoir Salt Cedar Eradication Project, Galisteo Creek, Santa Fe County, New Mexico. The project will remove salt cedar through mechanical extraction along 300 acres upstream of the Galisteo Dam and Reservoir.
