

**Notice of Availability
Draft Environmental Assessment for the
Pueblo of Zuni Constructed Wetlands**

The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (Corps), Albuquerque District, has completed the **Draft Environmental Assessment (DEA)** entitled **“Pueblo of Zuni Constructed Wetlands Wastewater Treatment Lagoons, McKinley County, New Mexico”**. The Corps, in cooperation with the Pueblo of Zuni, is planning a project to increase the capacity of the Zuni secondary wastewater treatment wetlands. The proposed work would construct ten additional secondary treatment wetland cells within a 200-acre area on Zuni Pueblo land, southwest of Zuni village in southwestern McKinley County. Two cells would be constructed initially, and future cells would be added as funding becomes available. The proposed construction period is nine months and is expected to start in the fall of 2008.
