

## Bottomless Lakes State Park, Roswell, New Mexico

(Section 206)

The project is located at Bottomless Lakes State Park, 13 miles east of Roswell, NM.

The New Mexico Environmental Department has requested that the Corps of Engineers undertake a Section 206 Environmental Restoration study to replace wetlands that have been lost over the years within the Pecos River Basin. The project also has the potential to reduce nuisance flooding within the State Park, around the perimeter of Lea Lake.

The Preliminary Restoration Plan (PRP) was approved in February 2003. The feasibility study is scheduled to begin in August 2003.

The project will be funded under the Construction General, Continuing Authorities Program
