These four sub-categories are not new exclusions, but are simply administrative distinctions and remain (b)(1) exclusions as defined by the NWPR.

			potentially flow overland to the southeast but would be
			captured by a depressional basin that is dominated by
			willows located immediately northwest of an RV Park.
			This basin does not have an outlet. On 4 separate
			occasions (SPK-2018-00794, SPK-2020-00597, SPK-
			2020-00831, SPK-2020-00923.) the Corps determined
			that this wetland and another wetland that also flows
			into this scrub shrub wetland was an intrastate, isolated
			wetland and therefore not a waters of the U.S. There is
			not a surface connection to a Traditional Navigable
			Water (TNW) and no evidence of a subsurface
			connection. The closest TNW is the Animas River,
			which is approximately 2,200-linear feet to the east.
			For these reasons, it has been determined that the
			Block 58, Lots 22-24 Wetlands are not jurisdictional
			under the Navigable Waters Protection Rule.
