	The review area is comprised entirely of dry land (i.e., there are no waters or water features, including
	wetlands, of any kind in the entire review area). Rationale: The area of interest is 780 linear feet of a
	water feature described as an arroyo. The subject arroyo possessed no indicators of a defined channel
	such as low-flow channel(s), floodplain, or Ordinary High Water Mark (OHWM). The site is comprised
	entire of uplands and upland drainge features. The water feature was previously severed from flowing
	downstream by the waste treatment facilty in the early 2000's which would make this an isolated
	waterway if the water featured had a defined bed and bank with an observable ordinary high water
	mark.
