The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (Corps), Albuquerque District, has posted a **“Draft Integrated Letter Report and Programmatic Environmental Assessment Federal Participation in Watercraft Inspection Stations Upper Colorado River Basin”** on the district website. The Draft Letter Report summarizes existing watercraft inspection stations in the states of Arizona, Colorado, New Mexico, Utah and Wyoming, and describes possible cost-shared measures between states and the Corps to improve the effectiveness of water craft inspections to protect the Upper Colorado River Basin.

Public review of the Draft Integrated Letter Report and Programmatic Environmental Assessment begins on October 26th, 2020, and comments are requested to be received no later than November 30th, 2020.
