The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (Corps), Albuquerque District, in cooperation with and at the request of the Village of Canjilon and the Mutual Domestic Water Consumers and Mutual Sewage Works Association (MDWC&MSWA), has completed the Draft Environmental Assessment (EA), titled, "Environmental Assessment for the Canjilon Water System Improvements Project". The purpose of this project is to make improvements to the existing water system. The improvements include replacing 3-inch existing water lines with larger sized 6-inch water lines through parts of the Village. Existing water lines would be abandoned in place and would not be removed. The improvements to the water system would provide consistent and adequate pressure to the water system for existing consumers as well as aid in fire protection. The proposed construction period is twelve months and is expected to start in January 2022.
