Draft Environmental Assessment and Finding of No Significant Impact Middle Venada Arroyo Water Quality Improvement Project Sandoval County, NM

The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (Corps), Albuquerque District, in collaboration with the Southern Sandoval County Arroyo Flood Control Authority, has completed a Draft Environmental Assessment (EA) and draft Finding of No Significant Impact (FONSI) for the **Middle Venada Arroyo Water Quality Improvement Project in Sandoval County, New Mexico**. The Draft EA evaluates alternatives that would provide stormwater quality treatment in the Venada Arroyo. The project is located west of NM Highway 528 within the City of Rio Rancho and the Town of Bernalillo.

The proposed project would provide stormwater quality treatment in the Venada Arroyo before it discharges into the Rio Grande. Project features include two inline weir structures with a shallow-sloped settling area between them; a stilling basin downstream of the downstream weir; and riprap directly downstream of the stilling basin. The proposed project would allow sediment, floatable trash, and other contaminants to be captured before releasing into the Rio Grande.
