

**Notice of Availability**  
**Draft Environmental Assessment, Northgate Diversion Channel, El Paso, Texas**

The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (Corps), Albuquerque District and El Paso Water Utilities (EPWater) have completed the **Draft Environmental Assessment (DEA) entitled “Northgate Diversion Channel, El Paso, Texas”**. The Corps, in cooperation with and at the request of EPWater, is planning to improve the channel to more effectively convey stormwater. Proposed improvements include grading the existing earthen channel and lining it with concrete, stabilizing the channel’s upstream end with rock riprap, and constructing a series of baffles dissipate energy at the downstream end of the concrete channel. A graphic of the proposed project location is attached below.

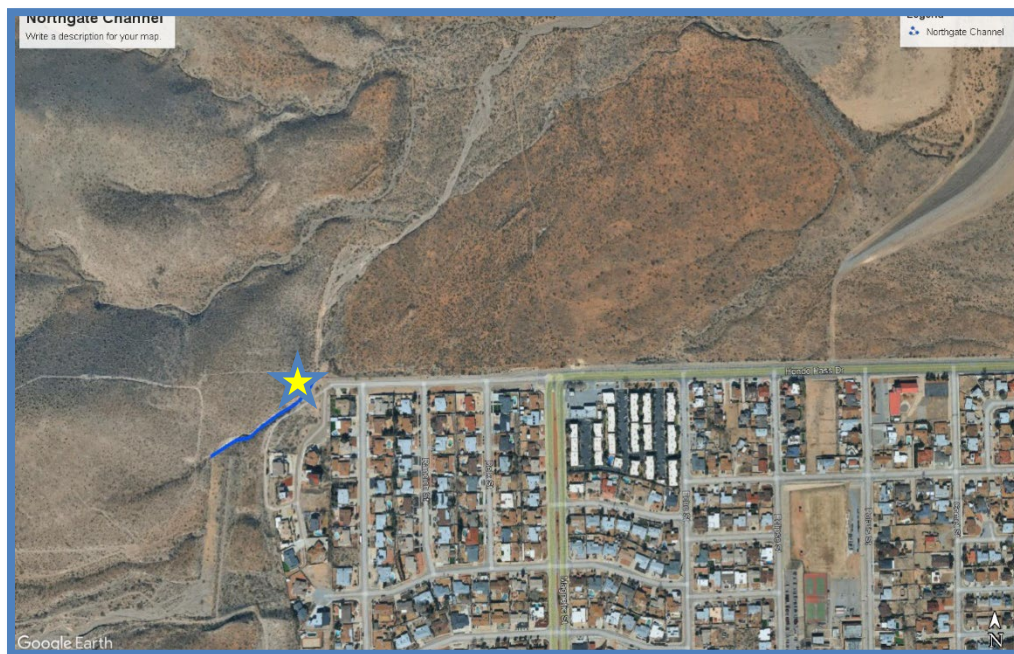
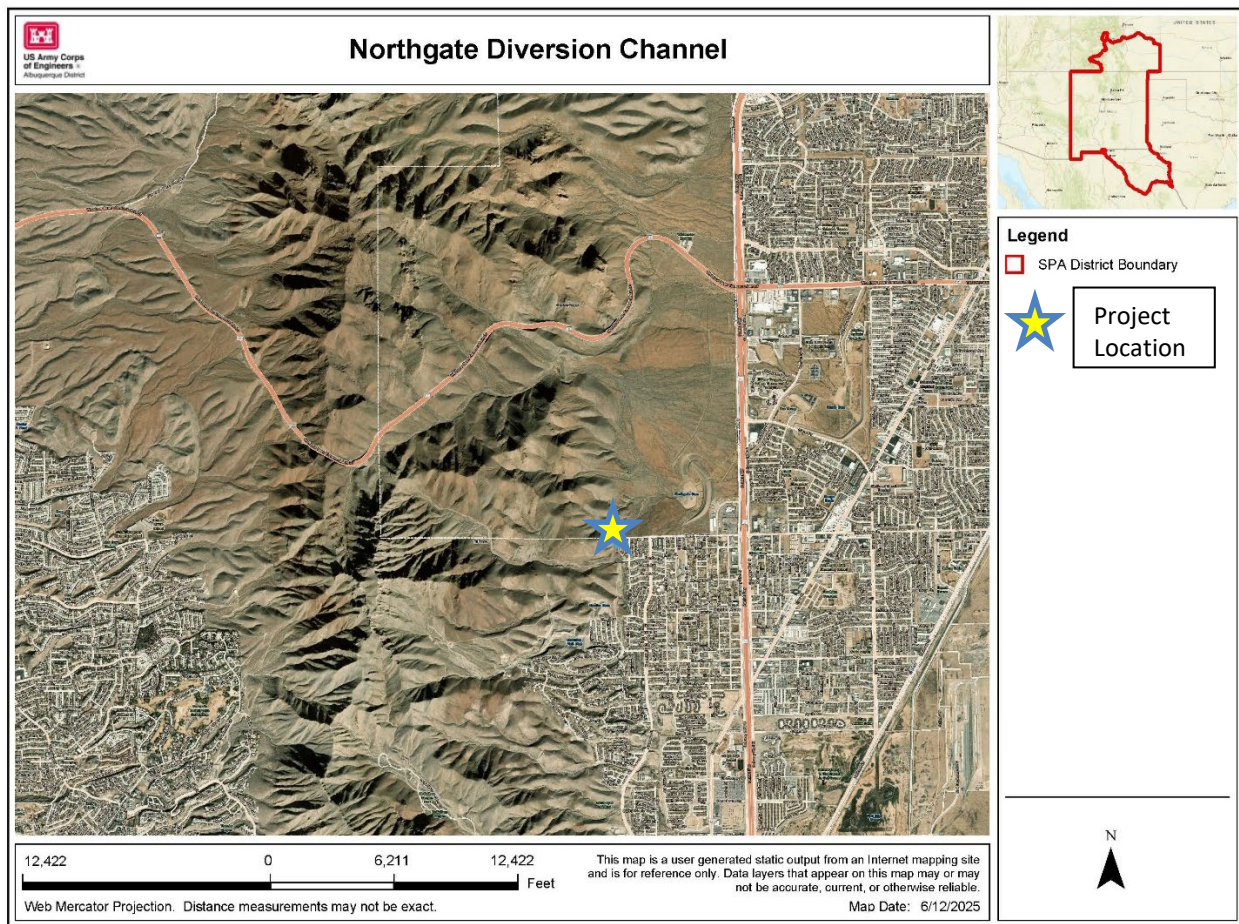
